TheGreenBow macOS VPN Client 1.2.7

Features, improvements and fixes of release 1.2.7

- Feature: the app can now be downloaded directly from TheGreenBow web site
- Feature: the app must now be activated with a license key from TheGreenBow
- Feature: the app is now distributed as a DMG installer
- Feature: support of OpenVPN (SSL tunnels)
- Feature: added AES-CTR and AES-GCM encryption methods
- Feature: added Trace Mode
- Feature: added Dark Mode support
- Feature: French language support
- BugFix: fixed editing issue when clicking on the tunnel name
- BugFix: fixed crash when trying to open an empty IKE v2 tunnel
- BugFix: Dead Peer Detection now correctly used to close tunnel when no traffic is detected
- BugFix: all IKEv2 identity types are now correctly saved in configuration file

Features, improvements and fixes of release 1.1.14

- BugFix: names on the network where tunnel is open are not resolved.
- BugFix: checking the box "IKEv2 Fragmentation" doesn't have any effect.

TheGreenBow macOS VPN Client 1.1.13

Features of release 1.1.13

- Feature: compatible with virtually all existing IPsec IKEv2 compliant gateways
- Feature: DH Group 1-18, 3DES, AES 128-256, SHA2 256-384-512
- Feature: EAP, Certificates, PSK
- Feature: Redundant Gateway, DPD
- Feature: Mode Config (auto, manual)
- Feature: Compatible with macOS 10.11+
